Applications are invited, on proforma given below, from eligible candidates for 10 (ten) posts of Deputy Advocate Generals and 10 (ten) posts of Assistant Advocate Generals, purely on provisional/contract basis, initially for a period of one year, for the office of Advocate General, Haryana. Applications must be sent on or before 10/01/2018. The Haryana Law Officers (Engagement) Act, 2016 and the Rules made thereunder, prescribing requisite qualifications/standing/requirements, are available on the official Website of the office of Advocate General, Haryana at <https://advocategeneralhry.gov.in> and the official Website of this Department at <https://homeharyana.gov.in>. The candidate must possess the following minimum qualifications:-

- i) he is a citizen of India;
- ii) he is enrolled with a Bar Council constituted under the Advocates Act, 1961 (Act 25 of 1961);
- iii) he has been practicing in any Court of law within the jurisdiction of India;
- iv) he is a duly assessed income tax payee for the gross minimum income from legal profession as Rs. 7,00,000/- per annum for the post of Deputy Advocate General and Rs. 3,50,000/- per annum for the post of Assistant Advocate General.
- v) he must have experience of practicing as an Advocate not less than 8 years and 5 years and conducted 35 and 25 cases in last one year for the post of Deputy Advocate General and Assistant Advocate General respectively.


Besides, an Advocate shall be disqualified for being appointed as a Law Officer, if:

- a) he is a person of unsound mind;
- b) he is an undischarged insolvent;
- c) he has been convicted of an offence involving moral turpitude and such conviction has not been reversed or he has not been granted full pardon in respect of such offence;
- d) he has been held guilty of encroachment on any public property;

- e) he has been or is disqualified by the Bar Council of the State, where he has been enrolled or Bar Council of India or any court or authority;
- f) he, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage; or
- g) he has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living.
