Sir,

May kindly refer to the earlier correspondence regarding the requirement of Haryana for Central Para Military Forces in order to deal with the situation arising out of the Court verdict to be announced on 25.08.2017 in the case relating to head of Dera Sacha Sauda. Against the requirement of 150 companies, 53 companies have been provided till date. Today CWP No.19086 of 2017 had come up for hearing in the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court. The Hon'ble High Court has given the following directions:-

"The Central Government shall provide adequate security and force to the State Government for maintaining peace and law and order in Panchkula and its surrounding areas forthwith.

The Union of India through the Home Secretary shall provide force including paramilitary forces keeping in view the gravity of the situation."

I would request that as per the demand of the State, 97 more Coys. of the Paramilitary forces may be made available immediately to the State. Hon'ble High Court has asked for an update today itself.

You are, therefore, requested to take necessary action as mentioned above.



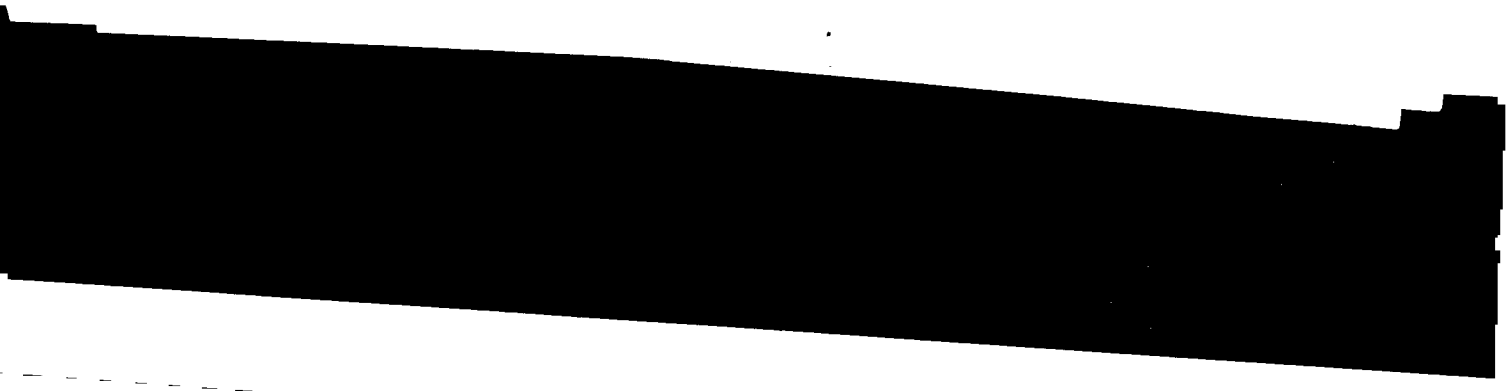
