HARYANA GOVERNMENT HOME DEPARTMENT Notification

The 20th May, 1980

No. G.S.R. 68/Const./Art. 309/80.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Haryana hereby makes the following rules regulating the recruitment and conditions of service of persons appointed to the Haryana Forensic Science Group B Service, namely :—

PART I—GENERAL

1. These rules may be called the Haryana Forensic Science Group B Short title, Service Rules, 1980.

2. In these rules unless the context otherwise requires,—

Definition.

(a) "Commission" means the Haryana Public Service Commission ;

(b) "Direct Appointment" means an appointment made otherwise than by promotion or by transfer of an official already in service, of the Government of India or any State Governments.

(c) "Director" means the Director, Forensic Science Laboratory, Haryana ;

(d) "Government" means Haryana Government in the administrative Department ;

(e) "Inspector-General" means the Inspector-General of Police, Haryana ;

(f) "Recognised University" means—

(i) any University incorporated by law in India ;
(ii) in the case of degree or diploma or certificate obtained as a result of examinations held before the 15th August, 1947, the Punjab, Sind or Dacca University, and

(iii) any other University which is declared by the Government to be a recognised University for the purpose of these rules ;

(g) "Service" means Haryana Forensic Science Group B Service.

PART II—RECRUITMENT TO SERVICE

3. The service shall comprise the posts shown in Appendix A. to these rules ;
Provided that nothing in these rules shall affect the inherent right of the Government to make additions to or reduction in the number of such posts or to create new posts with different designations and scales of pay, either permanently or temporarily.

4. (1) No person shall be appointed to the service unless he is—

(a) a citizen of India, or

- (b) a subject of Nepal, or
- (c) a subject of Bhutan, or
- (d) a Tibetan refugee who came over to India before the 1st January, 1962, with the intention of permanently settling in India, or
- (e) a person of Indian origin who has migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka, East African Countries of Kenya, Uganda, the United Republic of Tanzania (formerly Tanganyika and Zanzibar), Zambia, Malawi, Zaire and Ethiopia with the intention of permanently settling in India :

Provided that a person belonging to category (b), (c), (d), or (e) shall be a person in whose favour a certificate of eligibility has been issued by the Government.

- (2) A person in whose case a certificate of eligibility is necessary may be admitted to an examination or interview conducted by the Commission or any other recruiting authority, but the offer of appointment may be given only after the necessary eligibility certificate has been issued to him by the Government.

- (3) No person shall be appointed to the Service by direct recruitment unless he produces a certificate of character from the principal academic officer of the University, college or institution last attended, if any, and similar certificates from two other responsible persons, not being his relatives, who are well acquainted with him in his private life and are unconnected with his university, college or institution.

Age.

- 5. No person shall be appointed to the service by direct recruitment who is less than 20 years or more than 45 years of age on or before the 1st day of February next preceding the last date of submission of applications to the Commission :
- Provided that in the case of regular Government employees other than *ad hoc* employees, who are appointed by transfer, there will be no upper age limit :

Provided further that upper age limit shall be relaxable in the case of Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Backward Classes and Ex-Servicemen in accordance with the instructions issued by the State Government in this behalf from time to time.

- 6. Appointment to the posts in the Service shall be made by the Government.
- 7. No person shall be appointed to the Service unless he is in possession of qualifications and experience specified in column 2 of Appendix B to these rules.
- 8. No person,
 - (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or

- (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to any post in the Service;

Provided that the Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6 9. (1) Recruitment to the Service shall be made—

(i) by promotion; or

(ii) by direct recruitment; or

(iii) by transfer or deputation of an employee already in the service of any State Government or the Government of India.

Method of recruitment.

(2) When any vacancy occurs or is about to occur in the Service, the Government shall determine the manner in which such vacancy shall be filled.

(3) Appointment by promotion shall be made by seniority-cum-merit and no member of the Service shall be entitled to such appointment as of right.

10. (1) Persons appointed to any post in the Service shall remain on probation for a period of two years, if appointed by direct recruitment and one year, if appointed otherwise.

Provided that—

(a) any period after such appointment spent on deputation on a corresponding or a higher post shall count towards the period of probation;

(b) any period of work in equivalent or higher rank prior to appointment to the Service may, in the case of an appointment by transfer, at the discretion of the appointing authority be allowed to count towards the period of probation fixed under this rule; and

(c) any period of officiating appointment shall be reckoned as period spent on probation but no person who has so officiated shall, on the completion of the prescribed period of probation, be entitled to be confirmed, unless he is appointed against a permanent vacancy.

(2) If, in the opinion of the appointing authority, the work or conduct of a person during the period of probation is not satisfactory, it may,—

(a) if such person is appointed by direct recruitment, dispense with his services; and

- (b) if such person is appointed otherwise than by direct recruitment,—
 - (i) revert him to his former post ; or
 - (ii) deal with him in such other manner as the terms and conditions of the previous appointment permit.
- (3) On the completion of the period of probation of a person, the appointing authority may,—
 - (a) if his work or conduct has, in its opinion, been satisfactory,—
 - (i) confirm such person from the date of his appointment, if appointed against a permanent vacancy ; or
 - (ii) confirm such person from the date from which a permanent vacancy occurs, if appointed against a temporary vacancy ; or
 - (iii) declare that he has completed his probation satisfactorily, if there is no permanent vacancy ; or
 - (b) if his work or conduct has, in its opinion, been not satisfactory,—
 - (i) dispense with his services, if appointed by direct recruitment, if appointed otherwise, revert him to his former post or deal with him in such other manner as the terms and conditions of previous appointment permit ; or
 - (ii) extend his period of probation and thereafter pass such order, as it could have passed on the expiry of the first period of probation ; provided that the total period of probation, including extension, if any, shall not exceed three years.

Seniority
of members
of Service.

11. Seniority, *inter se*, of members of the Service shall be determined by the length of continuous service on any post in the Service :

Provided that in the cases of members appointed by direct recruitment, the order of merit determined by the Commission, shall not be disturbed in fixing the seniority :

Provided further that in the case of two or more members appointed on the same date, their seniority shall be determined as follows :—

- (a) a member appointed by direct recruitment shall be senior to a member appointed by promotion or by transfer ;
- (b) a member appointed by promotion shall be senior to a member appointed by transfer ;
- (c) In the case of members appointed by promotion or by transfer, seniority shall be determined according to the seniority of such members in the appointments from which they were promoted or transferred ; and

- (d) in the case of members appointed by transfer from different cadres, their seniority shall be determined according to pay, preference being given to a member, who was drawing a higher rate of pay in his previous appointment, and if the rates of pay drawn are also the same then by the length of their service in the appointments, and if the length of such service is also the same, the older member shall be senior to the younger member.

12. A member of the Service shall be liable to serve at any place whether within or outside the State of Haryana.

Liability to serve.

A member of the Service may also be deputed for service as under :—

- (i) a company, association or body of individuals whether incorporated or not, which is wholly or substantially owned or controlled by the State Government, a municipal corporation or a local authority within the State of Haryana ;
- (ii) the Central Government or a company, association or body of individuals whether incorporated or not, which is wholly or substantially owned or controlled by the Central Government; or
- (iii) another State Government, an International organisation, an autonomous body not controlled by the Government, or a private body :

Provided that no member of the Service shall be deputed to the Central or any other State Government or any organisation or body referred to in clauses (ii) and (iii) except with his consent.

13. In respect of pay, leave, pension and all other matters, not expressly provided for in these rules, the member of the Service shall be governed by such rules and regulations as may have been or may hereafter be adopted or made by the competent authority under the Constitution of India or under any law for the time being in force made by the State Legislature.

Leave, pension, other matters.

14. (1) In matters relating to discipline, penalties and appeals, members of the service shall be governed by the Punjab Civil Services (Punishment and Appeal) Rules, 1952, as amended from time to time:

Discipline, penalties and appeals.

Revised

Provided that the nature of penalties which may be imposed, the authority empowered to impose such penalties and appellate authority shall, subject to the provisions of any law or rules made under article 309 of the Constitution of India, be such as are specified in Appendix C to these rules.

- (2) The authority competent to pass an order under clauses (c) and (d) of sub-rule (1) of rule 10 of the Punjab Civil Services (Punishment and Appeals) Rules, 1952 shall also be as specified in Appendix D to these rules.

Vaccination

15. Every member of the Service shall get himself vaccinated and revaccinated if and when the Government so directed by a special or general order.

Oath of
allegiance.

16. Every member of the Service, unless he has already done so, shall be required to take the oath of allegiance to India and to the Constitution of India as by law established.

Power of
relaxation.

17. Where the Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, it may, by order for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

Special pro-
vision.

18. Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules, the appointing authority may impose special terms and conditions in the order of appointment if it is deemed expedient to do so.

Repeal and
savings.

19. Any rule applicable to the Service and corresponding to any of these rules which is in force immediately before the commencement of these rules is hereby repealed :

Provided that any order made or action taken under the rules so repealed shall be deemed to have been made or taken under the corresponding provision of these rules.

No. G.S.R. 22/Const./Art. 309/2003.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Haryana hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Haryana Forensic Science Group B Service Rules, 1980, namely :—

1. (1) These rules may be called the Haryana Forensic Science Group B Service (Amendment) Rules, 2003.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the official Gazette.

2. In the Haryana Forensic Science (Group B) Service Rules, 1980 (hereinafter called the said rules), in rule 2,—

(i) after clause (c), the following clause shall be inserted, namely :—

‘(cc) “Director-General of Police” means

the Director-General of Police, Haryana ;’ ;

(ii) Clause (e) shall be omitted.

3. In the said rules, for rule 9, the following rule shall be substituted, namely :—

“9. Method of recruitment.—(1) Recruitment to the Service shall be made,—(a) in case of Senior Scientific Officer (Chemistry, Physics, Biology, Serology, Ballistics, Documents, Lie-Detection, Instrumentation and Photo)—

(i) by promotion from amongst Senior Scientific Assistants of concerned divisions ; or

(ii) by direct recruitment ; or

(iii) by transfer or deputation of an officer already in the service of any State Government or the Government of India ;

(b) in case of Senior Scientific Officer (General)—

(i) by promotion from amongst Senior Scientific Assistant General/ Chemistry/Physics/Biology/Serology/Ballistics/Documents ; or

(ii) by direct recruitment ; or

(iii) by transfer or deputation of an officer already in the service of any State Government or the Government of India ;

(c) in case of Senior Scientific Officer (Scene of Crime)—

(i) by promotion from amongst Senior Scientific Assistant (Scene of Crime); or

(ii) By direct recruitment; or

(iii) by transfer or deputation of an officer already in the service of any State Government or the Government of India.

(2) Appointment to any post in the Service by promotion shall be made on seniority-cum-merit basis and no person shall be entitled to claim promotion on the basis of seniority alone.”

4. In the said rules, in rule 11,—

(i) in the second proviso, in clause (d), for sign “.” existing at the end, the sign “:” shall be substituted.

(ii) the following proviso shall be added at the end, namely :—

“provided further that where there are different discipline in the service, the seniority shall be determined separately for each discipline unless otherwise specified.”

5. In the said rules, for rule 14, the following rule shall be substituted, namely :—

“14. Discipline, Penalties and Appeals.—(1) In matters relating to discipline, penalties and appeals, members of the service shall be governed by the Haryana Civil Services (Punishment and Appeal) Rules, 1987, as amended from time to time :

Provided that the nature of penalties which may be imposed, the authority empowered to impose such penalties and the appellate authority shall, subject to the provisions of any law or rules made under article 309 of the Constitution of India, be such as are specified in Appendix C to these rules.

(2) The authority competent to pass an order under clause (c) or clause (d) of sub-rule (1) of rule 9 of the Haryana Civil Services (Punishment and Appeal) Rules, 1987, shall be as specified in Appendix D to these rules.”

6. In the said rules, for Appendices A, B, C and D, the following appendices shall be substituted, namely :—

No. G.S.R.25/Const./Art.309/2012.— In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Haryana hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Haryana Forensic Science (Group A) Service Rules, 1980, namely:—

1. These rules may be called Haryana Forensic Science (Group A) Service (Amendment) Rules, 2012.

2. In the Haryana Forensic Science (Group A) Service Rules, 1980 (hereinafter called the said rules), in rule 9, in sub-rule (1),—

(I) in clause (b), for sub-clause (i), the following sub-clause shall be substituted, namely:—

“(i) by promotion from amongst Assistant Directors in different divisions as mentioned at serial number 3 to 15 in Appendix A; or” ;

(II) for clause (c), the following clause shall be substituted, namely:—

“(c) in case of Assistant Directors in different divisions as mentioned at serial number 3 to 14 in Appendix A,

(i) by promotion from amongst Senior Scientific Officers in concerned divisions; or

(ii) by direct recruitment; or

(iii) by transfer or deputation of an officer already in the service of any State Government or the Government of India”;

(III) after clause (c), the following clauses shall be added at end, namely “(d) in case of Assistant Director (Scene of Crime, General Division)”,

(i) by promotion from amongst Senior Scientific Officer (Chemistry, Physics, Biology, Serology, Documents, Lie-Detection, Scene of Crime, NDPS, Ballistics, DNA, Toxicology, Cyber Forensic); or

(ii) by direct recruitment; or

(iii) by transfer or deputation of an officer already in the service of any State Government or the Government of India”;

No.G.S.R.26/Const./Art.309/2012.-- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Haryana hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Haryana Forensic Science (Group B) Service Rules, 1980, namely: --

1. (1) These rules may be called Haryana Forensic Science (Group B) Service (Amendment) Rules, 2012.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Haryana Forensic Science (Group B) Service Rules, 1980 (hereinafter called the said rules), in rule 9, in sub-rule (1), for clauses (a), (b) and (c), the following clauses shall be substituted, namely:--

“(a) in case of Senior Scientific Officer (Chemistry, Physics, Biology, Serology, Ballistics, Documents, Lie-Detection, NDPS, DNA, Photo, Scene of Crime, Toxicology, Cyber Forensic, Explosive),-

(i) by promotion from amongst Senior Scientific Assistants of concerned divisions; or

(ii) by direct recruitment; or

(iii) by transfer or deputation of an officer already in the service of any State Government or the Government of India;”

“(b) in case of Senior Scientific Officer (Psychology),-

(i) by promotion from amongst Senior Scientific Assistants (Psychology/Lie-Detection); or

(ii) by direct recruitment; or

(iii) by transfer or deputation of an officer already in the service of any State Government or the Government of India;”

“(c) in case of Senior Scientific Officer (Diatomology),-

(i) by promotion from amongst Senior Scientific Assistants (Diatomology/Biology); or

(ii) by direct recruitment; or

(iii) by transfer or deputation of an officer already in the service of any State Government or the Government of India;"

संख्या सांकांनि० 19/संवि०/अनु० 309/2021.— भारत के संविधान के अनुच्छेद 309 के परन्तुक द्वारा प्रदत्त शक्तियों का प्रयोग करते हुए, हरियाणा के राज्यपाल, इसके द्वारा हरियाणा विधि विज्ञान ग्रुप ख सेवा नियम, 1980, को आगे संशोधित करने के निम्नलिखित नियम बनाते हैं, अर्थात्:—

- ये नियम हरियाणा विधि विज्ञान ग्रुप ख सेवा (संशोधन) नियम, 2021, कहे जा सकते हैं।
- हरियाणा विधि विज्ञान ग्रुप ख सेवा नियम, 1980 (जिन्हें इसमें, इसके बाद, उक्त नियम कहा गया है) में, नियम 14 के स्थान पर, निम्नलिखित नियम प्रतिस्थापित किया जाएगा, अर्थात्:—

“14 अनुशासन, शास्तियां तथा अपीले.— (1) अनुशासन शास्तियां तथा अपीलों से संबंधित मामलों में सेवा के सदस्य समय-समय पर यथा-संशोधित हरियाणा सिविल सेवा (दण्ड तथा अपील) नियम, 2016 द्वारा शासित होंगे:

परन्तु ऐसी शास्तियों का स्वरूप जो लगाई जा सकती हैं ऐसी शास्तियां लगाने के लिए सशक्त प्राधिकारी तथा अपील प्राधिकारी भारत के संविधान के अनुच्छेद 309 के अधीन बनाई गई किसी विधि या नियमों के उपबन्धों के अधीन रहते हुए वे होंगे जो इन नियमों के परिशिष्ट ‘ग’ में विनिर्दिष्ट हैं।

(2) हरियाणा सिविल सेवा (दण्ड तथा अपील) नियम, 2016 के नियम 9 के खंड (ग) या खंड (घ) के अधीन आदेश पारित करने के लिए सक्षम प्राधिकारी तथा अपील प्राधिकारी भी वह होगा जो इन नियमों के परिशिष्ट ‘घ’ में यथाविनिर्दिष्ट है।”।

No. G.S.R. 19/Const./Art. 309/2021.— In exercise of the powers conferred by the provision to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Haryana hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Haryana Forensic Science (Group B) Service Rules, 1980, namely:—

1. These rules may be called the Haryana Forensic Science (Group B) Service (Amendment) Rules, 2021.
2. In the Haryana Forensic Science (Group B) Service Rules, 1980 (hereinafter called the said rules), for rule 14, the following rule shall be substituted, namely:—

“14. Discipline, penalties and appeals.— (1) In matters relating to discipline, penalties and appeals, members of the Service shall be governed by the Haryana Civil Services (Punishment and Appeal) Rules, 2016, as amended from time to time:

Provided that the nature of penalties which may be imposed, the authority empowered to impose such penalties and appellate authority shall, subject to the provisions of any law or rules made under article 309 of the Constitution of India, be such as are specified in Appendix C to these rules.

(2) The authority competent to pass an order under clause (c) or clause (d) of rule 9 of the Haryana Civil Services (Punishment and Appeal) Rules, 2016 and the appellate authority shall be such as specified in Appendix D to these rules.”.

3. In the said rules, for Appendix A, the following Appendix shall be substituted, namely:—

- (vi) against serial number 6, in item (i), the words “with specialization in Forensic Documents” shall be omitted;
- (vii) against serial number 8, in item (i), the words “with specialization in Forensic Chemistry” shall be omitted;
- (viii) against serial number 12, in item (i), the words and sign “with specialization in Forensic Chemistry/Toxicology” shall be omitted;
- (ix) against serial number 14, in item (i), the words “with specialization in Chemistry” shall be omitted; and
- (x) for the words “Hindi upto Matric” and “Hindi/Sanskrit upto Matric standard or Higher education” wherever occurring, the words “Hindi or Sanskrit as one of the subject in Matric or Higher Education” shall be substituted.
