- (c) "Board" means the Subordinate Services Selection Board, Haryana;
- (d) "Deputy Inspector-General" means the Deputy Inspector-General
- (e) "Direct appointment" means an appointment made otherwise than by promotion from within the service or by transfer of an official already in the service of State Government or the Govern-
- "Government" means the Haryana Government in the Administra-
- g) "Inspector-General" means the Inspector-General of Police,
  - "recognised university" means :-
- (i) any University incorporated by law in India; or
- ii) in the case of degree, diploma or certificate obtained as a result of an examination held before the 15th August, 1947, the Punjab. Sind or Dacca University; and
- (iii) any other university which is declared by the Government to be a recognised university for the purpose of these Rules.

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- (i) "Service" means the Haryana Police Clerical (State Service) III).
- (j) "Recognised Education Board" means any Education incorporated by law in any of the States of India.

## PART II-RECRUITMENT TO SERVICE

3. The service shall comprise the posts shown in Appendix A to these Rules

4. (1) No person shall be appointed to the service, unless he is:

Nationality, domicile and character of candidates appointed to the service.

- (c) a subject of Bhutan; or
- (d) a Tibetan refugee who came over to India before the 1st January, 1962, with the intention of permanently settling in India; a
- (e) a person of Indian origin who has migrated from Pakistan, Burma Sri Lanka (formerly Ceylon) and East African Countries of Kunya Uganda and United Republic of Tanzania (foremerly Tanganyika and Zanzibar) with the intention of permanently settling in India:

Provided that a person belonging to category (b), (c), (d) or (e) the be a person in whose favour a certificate of eligibility has been issued by the Government.

Note:—The promotion of Steno-typists or Steno graphers to posts in the Service for appointment to which they are under these Rules, shall be governed by the provisions Punjab Civil Services (Promotion of Stenographers and Stenoty, Rules, 1961.

  - (a) if such person is appointed by direct recruitment, disperse with his services; and
  - (b) if such person is appointed otherwise then by direct recrui
    - (i) revert him to his former post, or
    - (ii) deal with him in such other manner a s the terms and condition of his appointment permit.
- (3) on the completion of the period of probation of a person, the appointing authority may,—
  - (a) if his work or conduct has, in its opinion, been patisfactory,-
    - (i) confirm such person from the date of his appointment, appointment is against permanent vacancy; or

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- (ii) confirm such person from the date from which a permanent vacancy occurs, if appointed against a temporary vacancy;
- (iii) declare that he has completed his probation satisfactorily, if there is no permanent vacancy; or
- (b) if his work or conduct has, in its opinion, been not satisfactory:
  - (i) dispense with his services, if appointed by direct recruitment, if appointed otherwise, revert him to his former post or deal with him in such other manner as the terms and conditions of his previous appointment permit; or
  - (ii) extend his period of probation and thereafter pass such order, as it could have passed on the expiry of the first period of probation:

Provided that the total period of probation including extension, if any, shall not exceed three years.

11. The seniority inter se of members of the Service shall be determined Seniority of separately for each cadre by the length of continuous service on any post in Members of the Service. In case of promotion, the length of service on a post shall be the service. counted from the date of order of promotion:

Provided that in the case of members appointed by direct recruitment, the order of merit determined by the Board, as the case may be, shall not be disturbed in fixing the seniority:

Provide That in the case of two or more members appointed on the same date, their seniority shall be determined as follows :-

- (a) a member appointed by direct recruitment shall be senior to a member appointed by promotion or by transfer:
- (b) a member appointed by promotion shall be senior to a member appointed by transfer:
- (c) in the case of members appointed by promotion or by transfer, seniority shall be determined according to the seniority of such mer ibers in the appointments from which they were promoted or transferred; and
- (d) in the case of members appointed by transfer from different cadres their seniority shall be determined according to the pay, preference being given to a member who was drawing a higher rate of pay in his previous appointment; and if the rates of pay drawn are lso the same, than by their length of service in the appointments, ad if the length of such service is also the same, an older member slll be senior to a younger member.

-The posts of Clerks and Steno-typists shall be treated as the me class of posts for the purposes of preparing a joint senicty list for making promotions to higher posts, their senicty inter se reckoning from their dates of joining the posts

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Note 2.— The posts of Senior Scale Stenographers and Assistants would be interchangeable and treated as the same class of posts for the purposes of preparing a joint seniority list for making promotion to higher posts, their seniority inter se reckoning from the dates they have become due for promotion as Assistant.

Note 3.— The inter se seniority of Personal Assistant with that of Deputy Superintendent shall be reckoned only from the date, the Personal Assistant becomes due for promotion as Deputy Superintendent in his capacity as Assistant.

Liability to serve.

- 12.(1) A member of the Service shall be liable to serve under the State Government at any place whether within or outside the State of Haryana.
  - (2) A member of the Service may also be deputed for service as under :-
    - (i) a company, or association or a body of individuals whether incorporated or not, which is wholly or substantially owned or controlled by the State Government, Municipal Corporation or a local authority, within the State of Haryana;
    - (ii) the Central Government or a company, an association or a body of individuals whether incorporated or not, which is wholly or substantially owned or controlled by the Central Government;
    - (iii) any other State Government, an international organisation, an autonomous body not controlled by the Government or a private body:

Provided that no member of the service shall be deputed to the Central or any other State Government or any organisation or body referred to in clauses (ii) and (iii) except with his content.

Leave, Pension or other matters. 13. In respect of pay, leave, pension and all other matters not expressly provided for in these rules, the members of the service shall be governed by such rules and regulations as may have been, or may hereafter be adopted or made by the competent authority under the Constitution of India or under made thereunder.

Discipline, Penalties of the Service shall be governed by the Punjab Civil Services (Punishment and Appeals, and Appeal) Rules, 1952, as amended from time to time:

Provided that the nature of penalties which may be imposed, the authority empowered to impose such penalties and appeare authority the Constitution of India, be such as are specified in Appedix C to these

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- 15. Evey member of the Service shall get himself vaccinated and revaccinated if and when the Government so directs by a special or general tion.
- 16. Evey member of the Service, unless he has already done so, shall be required to take the oath of allegiance to India and to the Constitution Allegiance.
- 17. Where the Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, Power of category of persons.

No. G.S.R. 114/Corst./Art. 309/Amd.(1)/78.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the provise to article 309 of the Constitution of India, and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Haryana hereby makes the following rules to amend the Punjab Civil Services (Promotion of Stenographers and Steno-typists) Rules, 1961, namely:—

- 1. These rules may be called the Punjab Civil Services (Promotion of Stenographers and Steno-typists) Haryana First Amendment Rules, 1978
- 2. In the Punjab Civil Services (Promotion of Stenographers and Steno-typists) Rules, 1961 (hereinafter referred to as the said rules), in rule 3, for sub-rule (1), the following sub-rule shall be substituted, namely:—
  - "(I) In offices where the scale of pay of Stenographers is identical to that of Assistants, the Stenographers shall, before becoming eligible for promotion to a higher post on the clerical side, bave to work as Assistant for a period of two years on some existing vacancy or by sharing the work of an Assistant.
  - Explanation 1.—The period during which a Stenographer has, before the date of issue of these rules, performed the duties of an Assistant whether in addition to his own duties or otherwise will be taken into consideration in computing the period of his training as Assistant.
  - Explanation 2.—Where there is no available vacancy of the post of Assistant for imparting training to the Stenographer, he shall be given at least one-third of the work of some Assistant in addition to his own duties. The Assistant who is thus relieved of some of his work will in turn help the Stenographer in his routine duties."
- 3. In the said rules, in sub-rule (1) of rule 4, the words "after they have qualified in the departmental test prescribed for the post of Assistant" shall be omitted.
- 4. In the said rules, in sub-rule (1) of rule 5, the words "after they have qualified in the departmental test prescribed for the post of Assistant" shall be omitted.
  - 5. In the said rules, the proviso to sub-rule (I) of rule 6 shall be omitted
- 6. In the said rules, after rule 8, the following rule shall be added, namely 5:-
  - "9. Power of relaxation.—Where the Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, it may, by order for reasons to be recorded in writing, relex any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons".

- 3. In Appendix B to the Haryana Police Clerical (State Service, Class III) Rules, 1977, for item "Clerks", and entries thereafter the following item shall be substituted, namely:—

- 1. These rules may be called the Haryana Police Clerical (State Service, Class III) (Amendment) Rules, 2013.
- 2. In the Haryana Police Clerical (State Service, Class III) Rules, 1977 (hereinafter called the said rules), after rule 9, the following rule shall be inserted, namely:—
  - 9A (1) Typing test is substituted with the State Eligibility Test in Computer Appreciation and Applications (SETC) as a part of service requirement for Clerks, Steno-typists, Junior Scale Stenographers and Senior Scale Stenographers. The State Eligibility Test in Computer Appreciation and Application (SETC) shall be a post requisite condition/qualification which all the newly recruited/appointed Clerks, Steno-typists, Junior Scale Stenographers and Senior Scale Stenographers in the Government Departments/Organizations shall have to qualify. The existing Clerks, who have been promoted from Group-D and Restorer etc. who have not passed the typing test till date as required under the Service Rules shall have an option either to pass the typing test or the State Eligibility Test in Computer Appreciation and Applications (SETC). The Steno-typists, Junior Scale Stenographers and Sr. Scale Stenographers shall also have to qualify Stenography test as prescribed in the Service Rules.
    - (2) The candidate shall have to qualify the State Eligibility Test in Computer Appreciation and Application (SETC) within the probation period of two years, extendable by one year in case of direct recruit. The candidate appointed against the aforesaid categories of posts in Group C shall not be entitled to earn any increment in his/her pay scale till he/she qualifies the said test, failing which the services of such employees shall be dispensed with. The persons who are promoted to the post of Clerk and Steno-typists shall also qualify the State Eligibility Test in Computer Appreciation and Applications (SETC) within the period of probation of one year extendable by one year, failing which he/she will be reverted back.
    - (3) The Government of Haryana hereby authorizes the Haryana State Electronic Development Corporation Limited (HARTON) or any other agency as prescribed by the Government, as the authorized Agency for conducting the State Eligibility Test in Computer Appreciation and Application (SETC), alongwith a test in typing speed in accordance with the syllabus as the State Government may specify in this regard from time to time, besides the syllabus already provided in sub-rule (4) of this rule. The 'pass' certificate issued by HARTON or any other agency, as approved by the Government,

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- would be accepted as an evidence of the fulfillment of the prescribed condition in the Service Rules.
- (4) The syllabus for the State Eligibility Test in Computer Appreciation and Applications (SETC) would contain Word processing, Internet Browsing and E-mail management only.
- (5) In the case of Clerks, typing speed of 30 words per minutes in English and 25 words per minute in Hindi converted with equivalent key depressions in both cases as the typing speed would be tested on computers.
- (6) The employees possessing the following qualifications are exempted from taking the State Eligibility Test in Computer Appreciation and Applications (SETC):—
  - (i) M.Tech./B.Tech (Computers), MCA, BCA or Diploma in Computers from the recognized institutions e.g. Polytechnics;
  - (ii) Basic Computer Literacy Certificate from any recognized centre established under the National Institute of Electronics & Information Technology (NIELIT) [erstwhile DOEACC Society];
  - (iii) Haryana State Certificate in Information Technology [HS-CIT] from the Authorized Learning Centres (ALCs) of the HKCL;
  - (iv) Candidates/employees who have already passed the SETC and the same is valid at the time of joining the service. The State Eligibility Test in Computer Appreciation and Applications (SETC) passed by any candidate earlier shall be considered valid for a period of 5 years from the date of issue of such certificate by HARTON or any other agency authorized by the Government; and
  - (v) Physically disabled candidates i.e. amputation of hand (left and Right) Amputation of upper limbs, Paralysis of Radial Nerve (Radial Nerve Palsy) of either upper limb. Declination degenerative disorder effecting the nervous system which may cause paralysis and atrophy of the hand and its muscles and Visually Handicapped.

However, these employees, with the exception of those mentioned under subpara (v) above, shall be required to clear the 'typing test' being part of the State Eligibility Test in Computer Appreciation and Applications (SETC)."

- 3. In the said rules, in Appendix B;
  - I. against the post of Junior Scale Stenographers, under column 2, for existing item (1), the following item shall be substituted, namely:-
    - "(1) 10+2/Graduate or equivalent (for Ex-servicemen 10+2 only)";
  - II. against the post of Steno-typists, under column 2, for existing item (1), the following item shall be substituted, namely:-
    - "(1) 10+2/Graduate or equivalent (for Ex-servicemen 10+2 only)";

III. against the post of Clerks, under columns 2 and 3, for existing items, the following items shall be substituted, namely:-
