
Subject: Reg. serious violations of section 11(d) and 11(E) of the Prevention of Cruelty of Animal Act, 1960.

It has come to notice of government that serious violations of section 11 (d) and 11 E of the prevention of cruelty of Animal Act, 1960 (59 of 1960) as amended by the Central Act, 26 of 1982 are occurring in some parts of the State.

In particular, it has been noted that a large number of camels are being transported from Rajasthan to Uttar Pradesh and other states for illegal slaughter and are transiting and travelling through Haryana. The inhuman manner in which these animals are transported violating provision of the above said act has to be stopped with a firm hand while following the provisions of the law.

It is therefore, necessary that the police and the district administration along with other agencies involved in protecting animals rights must take all necessary action, to prevent this passage violative of the Act. It is further necessary that case duly registered under this and other relevant acts are pursued with vigor in the concerned law courts so that the objectives of law for prevention of cruelty animals are achieved.

District heads of police should sent periodic reports with regard to action taken with regard to animals being transported in a manner violating of law. It shall also be ensured by all authority of concerned to ensure that animals rescued are given treatment of the standards expected in the law.
