ORDER

In continuation and partial modification of the orders issued with Endst. of even No. dated 8th April, 2016, the Governor of Haryana is pleased to fix the terms and conditions of appointment of Mr. Justice (Retd.) S.N. Jha and Mr. N.C. Padhi, IPS (Retd.), appointed as Chairman and Member respectively, of the Commission of Inquiry constituted to look into the matter of agitation for demand of reservation by Jats during February, 2016.

Inquiry-Commission of of Chairman the Conditions Mr. Justice (Retd.) S.N. Jha will be as under:-

- Mr. Justice (Retd.) S.N. Jha, Chairman of the Commission will be paid salary/dearness allowance at par with the salary of the Chief Justice of Punjab and Haryana High Court minus pension.
- Allowances such as sumptuary allowance, house rent allowance in lieu of free furnished accommodation, free electricity up to prescribed limit, as fixed by rules/norms of the 2. Central Government at par with the Chief Justice of Punjab & Haryana High Court will be admissible.
- Air-conditioned car with fuel as per entitlement of Chief Justice of Punjab & Haryana High 3. Court will be given.
- Medical facilities/reimbursement as per entitlement of Chief Justice of Punjab & Haryana 4. High Court will be given.
- Telephone/mobile facilities will be provided at par with Chief Justice of Punjab & Haryana 5. High Court.
- Personal staff including Private Secretary, English knowing Stenographer, Peon will be 6. given as per entitlement.
- He is allowed to do legal practice in the Supreme Court subject to the condition that it will not detrimental to the interests of the State/Government of Haryana or the working of the 7. Commission.

Terms & Conditions of Member of the Commission Mr. N.C. Padhi, IPS (Retd.) will be as under:-

Mr. N.C. Padhi. IPS (Retd.) will be paid salary on basis of last pay drawn by him in the 1. apex scale of IPS minus pension.

Other Allowances will be provided as per norms/rules of the State Government as 2. admissible to serving Director General of Police.

- Personal Staff will be provided as per entitlement of a serving officer of the rank of DG in 3. IPS cadre.
- Conveyance and other facilities including Car, Telephone etc. will be provided as per 4. entitlement of serving DG in the IPS cadre.

The Headquarter of the Commission shall be at Gurgaon.

The Chairman and Member of the Commission may be provided security as per requirement.

The expenditure on the establishment of the Commission shall be made by Secretary to the Commission who will be Drawing & Disbursing and who shall maintain the accounts of the all expenditures.

And whereas the State Government is of the considered opinion that it is necessary to appoint a Commission of Inquiry under the Commission of Inquiry Act, 1952 to inquire into this definite matter of public importance;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 3 of the Commissions of Inquiry Act, 1952 (Act 60 of 1952), the Governor of Haryana hereby appoints a two - member Commission comprising Mr. Justice (retired) S.N. Jha as its Chairman and Mr. N.C. Padhi, IPS (retired) as a member as the Commission of Inquiry.

Terms of reference:-

- 1. The Commission shall make an inquiry with respect to :
 - the sequence of the events leading to, and all facts and circumstances relating to, the occurrence of violence leading to loss of lives, damage to properties, both private and public including roads, canals, Railway Stations, Police Stations and illegal felling of trees and the violation of Human Rights from 18th February to 23rd February, 2016 in Rohtak, Jhajjar, Sonepat, Jind, Hisar, Kaithal, Bhiwani and Panipat;
 - (b) existence of a deep rooted conspiracy, if any, behind the occurrence of violence to damage the social fabric of the society;
 - (c) and any such matter as may be found relevant in the course of the inquiry.

2. The inquiry by the Commission shall be in regard to complaints or allegations that may be made before the Commission by any individual or association in such form, as may be specified by the Commission.

3. The Commission shall devise and specify its own procedure for conduct of the inquiry subject to provisions of the Commissions of Inquiry Act, 1952.

4. The Commission shall submit its report to the State Government as soon as possible but not later than six months from the date of its first sitting.

5. The Headquarters of the Commission shall be at Chandigarh.

6. Further, the Governor of Haryana is of the opinion that having regard to the nature of the inquiry to be made by the Commission and other circumstances of the case, all the provisions of sub-sections (2), (3), (4) and (5) of Section 5 of the Commissions of Inquiry Act, 1952 (Act, 60 of 1952) should be made applicable to the Commission and the Governor of Haryana, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of the said Section, further directs that all the provisions of sub-sections (2), (3), (4) and (5) of that Section shall apply to the Commission.

- 4. The Commission shall submit its report to the State Government as soon as possible but not later than six months from the date of its first sitting.
- 5. The Headquarters of the Commission shall be at Gurgaon.

Further, the Governor of Haryana is of the opinion that having regard to the nature of the inquiry to be made by the Commission and other circumstances of the case, all the provisions of sub-sections (2), (3), (4) and (5) of Section 5 and Section 5A of the Commission of Inquiry Act, 1952 (Act 60 of 1952), should be made applicable to the Commission and the Governor of Haryana. in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-sections(1) of the said section, further directs that all the provisions of sub-sections (2), (3), (4) and (5) of Section 5 and Section 5A shall apply to the Commission.
